



Sydney Academy of Chess

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Dear Parent/Guardian,

Your son/daughter has indicated an interest in participating in the chess program run by the Sydney Academy of Chess in 2009. This program will take place on **Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday afternoons** from **3:00pm – 4:00pm** and will be held in 4J (classroom closest to bus stop on Longueville Road). Children attend one class per week, and the different days are for different experience and skill levels: Tuesday is for beginners and rookies; Wednesday is for intermediates; Thursday is for advanced players. The term dates are as follows:

Term 1: Wk 2 (3 rd /4 th /5 th Feb) – Wk 11 (7 th /8 th /9 th Apr)	Cost: \$80	Payment due: 3 rd /4 th /5 th Feb
Term 2: Wk 1 (28 th /29 th /30 th Apr) – Wk 11 (7 th /8 th /9 th Jul)	Cost: \$88	Payment due: 28 th /29 th /30 th Apr
Term 3: Wk 1 (28 th /29 th /30 th Jul) – Wk 10 (29 th /30 th Sep/1 st Oct)	Cost: \$80	Payment due: 28 th /29 th /30 th Jul
Term 4: Wk 1 (20 th /21 st /22 nd Oct) – Wk 9 (15 th /16 th /17 th Dec)	Cost: \$72	Payment due: 20 th /21 st /22 nd Oct

If your payment is not received by the required day, your child cannot take part in the class. There will be no refunds for students who miss classes during the term.

Chess is a valuable activity for children, developing their logical thinking skills, concentration and discipline, as well as being a source of much enjoyment!

What happens at the chess classes?

These classes include an interactive lesson and puzzles on a demonstration chess board. During the rest of the class children play games against each other, putting newly learned strategies into practice, and receiving personal feedback from the teacher. As the term progresses and the children become proficient in all the basics, the lessons will move on to more complex ideas such as strategy, middle game ideas and chess technique.
