The LCPS Frog Pond renovation in 2008 was made possible through the hard work and generous donations of many people and organisations, including:

- **The parent run LCPS Environment Group**
The Frog Pond was one the Group's main initiatives in 2008. The members assisted with the work. Parents Jayne Whitford and Susan Loane designed and constructed and organised the implementation of the Frog Pond renovation.
- **Many parents and children from the school**
Worked on implementing the new design by clearing and preparing the area; laying out the new design; and locating the new soil, rocks, fencing and plants.
- **The School Community**
The school principal, Mr Bob Lamaro provided moral support and practical assistance to the project. The teachers, Masterplan Committee, and Parents and Citizens Association also provided advice and assistance. The P&C also generously provided funding to the project.
- **Willoughby Council**
 - Simon Brown, the Wildlife Officer at Willoughby Council coordinated the Council's generous efforts and also provided labour and wildlife and frog pond construction expertise.
 - Conducted a "Build a Frog Bog" workshop at the site. Members of the general public and the school community participated in a hands-on education morning, learning about local suburban frogs; frog habitats; reptiles; plants and how to build your own frog pond. The knowledge was then put into practice with the participants renovating the pond and planting the garden beds.
 - Donated many of the materials (including plants, crushed sandstone, rocks, waterproof pond liner and filter fabric), tools and labour to assist with the construction.

Donated over 150 native plants.
- **Australian Project Services**
